In EYFS & Key Stage 1 we focus on:

Thoughtfulness (the ability to think deeply about their learning)

Respect (the ability to treat each other, the school and the environment in an appropriate and caring manner, to understand how others might feel in different circumstances and to be tolerant of other people's views and opinions)

Resilience (the ability to persevere when presented with a difficult problem/issue)

Co-operation (the ability to work well with others, support others and accept help)

In Key Stage 2 we include these and the following:

Communication (the ability to communicate with others through writing and discussion to share information appropriately and to be able to listen to each other)

Enquiry (the ability to find things out, be curious and ask good questions)

Morality (to know right from wrong, understand why there are rules and choose the appropriate behaviors)

Adaptability (the ability to change ways of thinking about the world, to try different approaches to tasks where necessary and to be able to cope with change)
